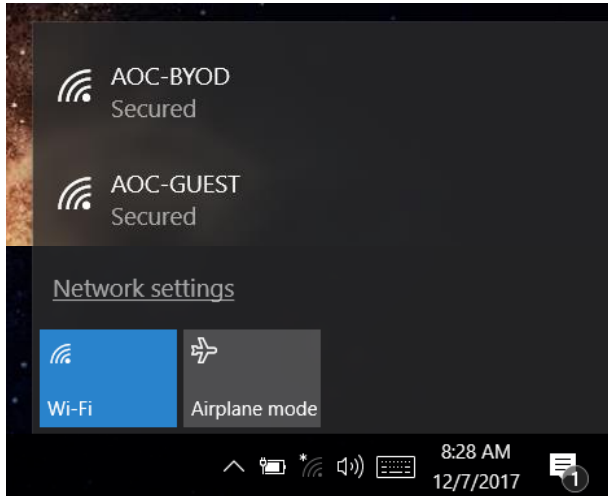




Using WiFi Networks

Connect to a Network

To access WiFi networks, click the WiFi icon in the notification area in the lower-right corner. If the icon is hidden, click the Show Hidden Icons button to view other icons.

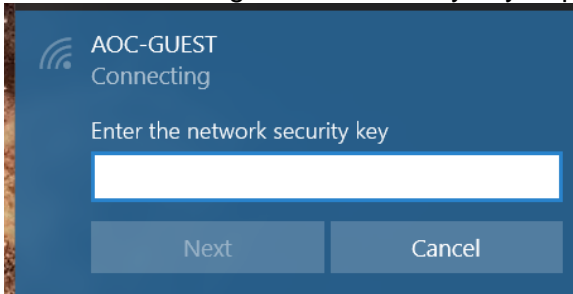


In the list of available networks, select the desired network.

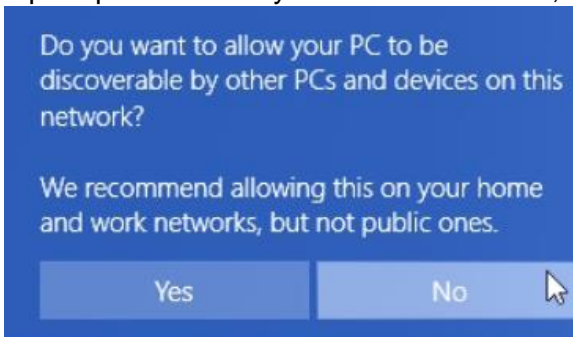
Guest WiFi

If you have guests attending meetings at the Quigley Center, Meyer Center, or an Archdiocese of Chicago remote site, and they need internet access, they can use our Guest WiFi connections.

- Connect to AOC-GUEST
- Enter the following network security key or password (if prompted) **stugu6ra**



If prompted to make your PC discoverable, choose No.





- A browser window should open prompting you to *Sign In* or *Register*. If you already have a Username and Password for AOC-GUEST, enter it and click Sign In. Otherwise, click Register.

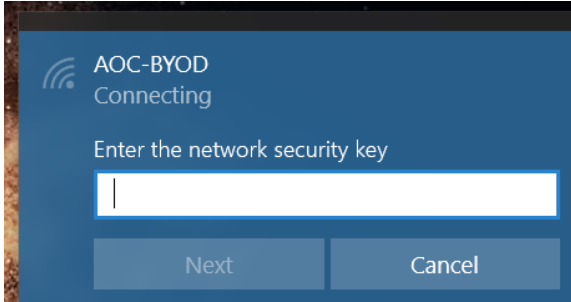

BYOD WiFi

AOC Employees can connect their personal devices to the **Bring Your Own Device**.

- Establish a connection to AOC-BYOD with your device, using *@835Chicago* as the password/authentication key.



- Open a web browser and browse to a new site.
- When prompted to sign in with your organizational account, enter your full *@archchicago.org* email address (again) and password.

Laptops provided by the Office of Information Technology are configured to connect to the AOC Employee WiFi network automatically when within range of that network.



Troubleshooting

Restart your computer. As you move around the building, you can end up disconnecting and reconnecting to several wireless access points the building. Restarting your computer is always a good first step in any compute troubleshooting.

Verify the login information. If you can't get past a login/security page, double-check that you are entering the username and password correctly and that you have been provided with the correct information.
